

Connect to ShipEngine

This guide will walk you through the steps needed to connect your ShipEngine account to Logicbroker.

1. Create a ShipEngine account

2. Set Up Carriers

You will need to add carriers in ShipEngine. You can use existing carrier accounts you have already set up or create new ones by logging into your carrier sites. For more information on connecting your carriers, follow ShipEngine's instructions provided in the link below.


Set Up ShipEngine Carriers




3. Add API key to Logicbroker

In this step you will make the connection between ShipEngine and Logicbroker by using your ShipEngine API key. It is recommended to begin this process in the Logicbroker stage portal first to verify your data is processing properly.

- 1. In the ShipEngine portal, navigate to Developer > API Keys
- 2. Click on **Create New Key** if you do not have one already
- 3. Copy the API Key



- 4. In the Logicbroker portal, navigate to Settings > Connections
- 5. Click on Connect to a New System and search for ShipEngine
- 6. Paste in your API Key



7. Save

4. Set Up Shipment Mappings

For retailers: If you plan on sending custom ship method codes on the order to be used to create labels, you will need to map to the standard codes listed below using Logicbroker's custom codes.



Once you have completed the steps above, you are able to start generating and printing shipping labels from the Logicbroker portal. See the steps below to see your connection in action and confirm the process works between Logicbroker and ShipEngine. For more details on this connector, review the following link:

ShipEngine

1. Create a shipment document

- 1. In the portal, pull up an order you wish to ship
- 2. Click on Ship in the top right to create a shipment document




2. Fill out the shipment document

- 1. Fill out **Ship From Address** or select one from the **Address Book**. See required fields below
 - First/Last Name
 - Line 1
 - City
 - State
 - Zip Code



- Country
- Phone
- 2. Under Packages, select the way you will be shipping
 - Both retailer and supplier accounts will appear here if they have been connected (the merchant's account or my account)
 - You may also choose not to use the ShipEngine connection for any given shipment and select **another system (manual entry)** to input your own carrier and tracking number from another source
- 3. Fill out package details. See required fields below
 - Dimensions (height, length, width, weight)
 - Quantity
 - Carrier *only required when using a supplier's account
- 4. Fill out any General Information details as needed
- 5. Submit







How will my labels be created?

Option 1: Pre-selected Carrier and Service Level on the order. If the order has a carrier and service level listed, the same carrier and service level will be used to create the shipment document and shipping label.

Option 2: Rate shop all connected carriers for lowest price. If the order does not have a carrier or service level listed (class code is blank or labeled as "UNSP"), then Logicbroker will use the Estimated Delivery Date to rate shop across all connected carriers and select the one with the lowest rate based on the accounts set up in ShipEngine.

The Carrier field refers to ShipmentInfos[0].ClassCode on the order

3. Print your shipping label

Once you submit your shipment, you will see the **Tracking Number** and **Carrier** fields auto-populate with the data matching the label. The shipping label will automatically populate, and you will be given the option to **Download** (to PDF) or **Continue**



Connect to ShipEngine

If you need to redownload the shipping label, from the shipment document, scroll down to **Attachments** and click on **Download**



If you are looking to ship using your merchant's or your own account, you can do so through the Logicbroker API as well. See our developer documentation below.
